NARRATIVE REPORT for a PLANNED AREA DEVELOPMENT OVERLAY DISTRICT of SADDLEBROOKE RANCH

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PURPOSE OF REQUEST

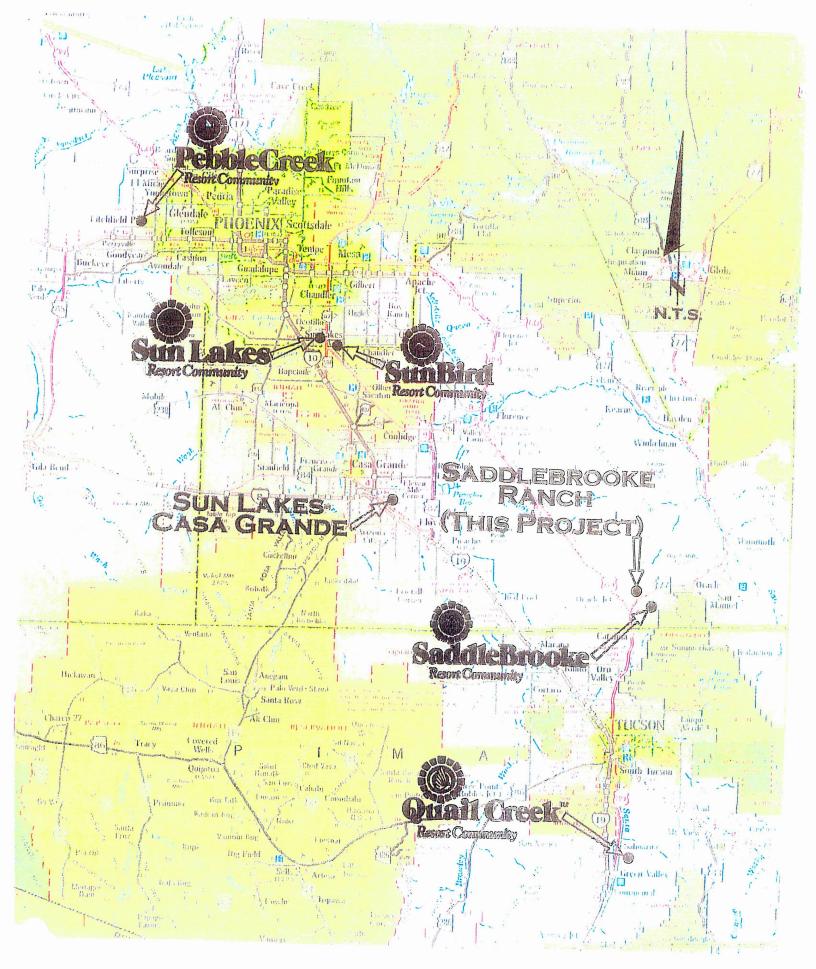
FVR Land Investment Company purchased 2253± acres of real property from Falcon Valley Ranch, Inc. in 1995 (the "FVR Property"). The FVR Property continues to be used by Falcon Valley Ranch, Inc. for cattle grazing purposes. Robson Ranch Mountains, LLC purchased 275 acres of real property from the State Land Department in December, 1999. That property, together with the FVR Property is referred to in this Report as the "Property". Robson Ranch Mountains, LLC desires to create a private, gated golf-oriented, adult community on the Property, to be known as SaddleBrooke Ranch.

The Property lies within the Falcon Valley Area Plan, a 37,370-acre Area Plan that was adopted by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors on January 11, 1988 and recorded with the Pinal County Recorder. The Pinal County Board of Supervisors approved a Phased Protected Development Rights Plan (the "PPDRP") for the FVR Property in 1995. FVR Land Investment Company and Pinal County executed the PPDRP and it was recorded with the Pinal County Recorder on September 25, 1995. A Supplement to the PPDRP, allowing development of the FVR Property as an adult residential community in a manner similar to the existing SaddleBrooke Resort Community, was approved by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors and was recorded with the Pinal County Recorder on May 11, 1998. Robson Ranch Mountains, LLC, an affiliate of the developer of the SaddleBrooke Resort Community, has an option to purchase and develop the FVR Property and will be responsible for performing all obligations of an owner or developer of the Property.

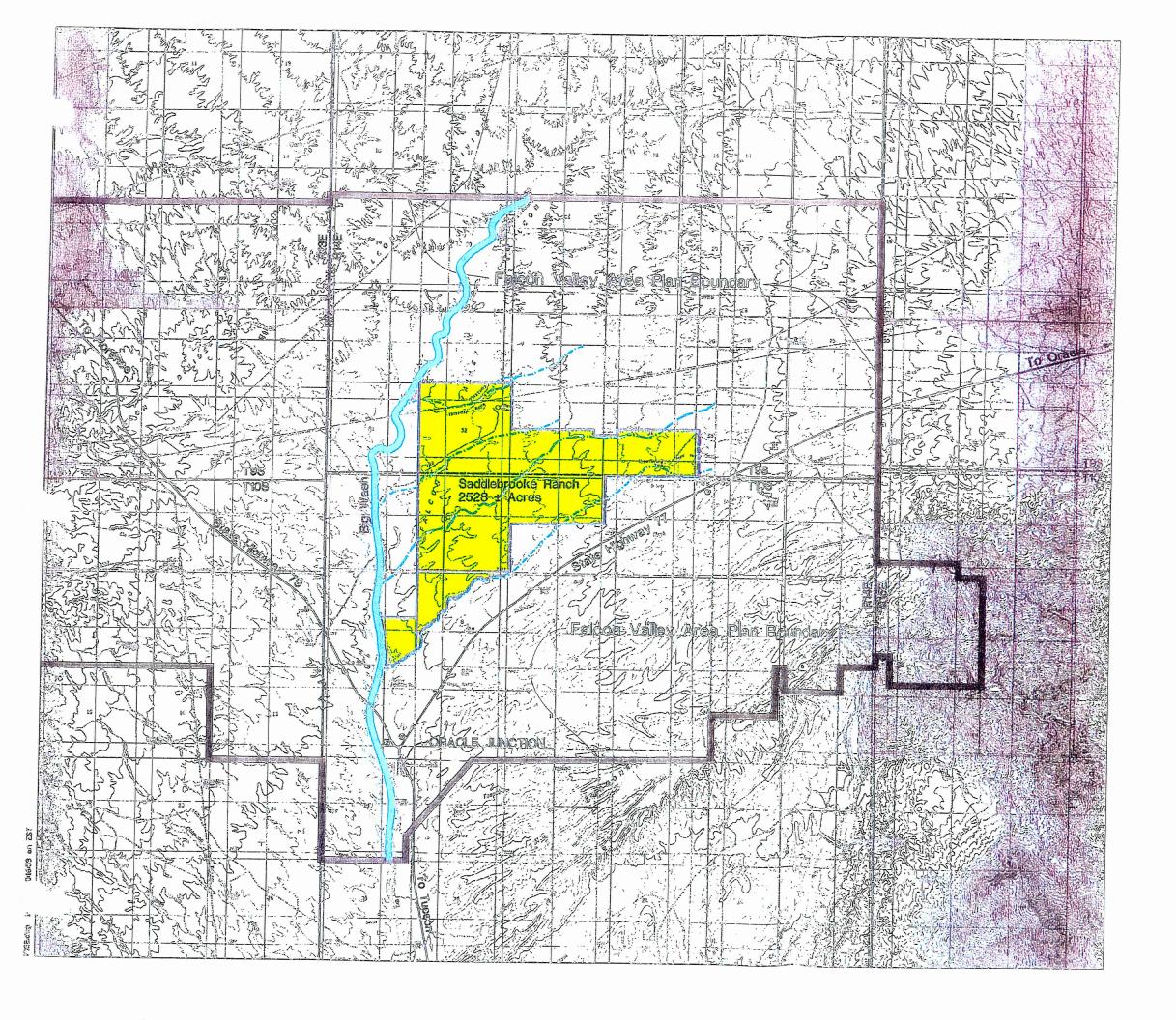
SaddleBrooke Ranch is located at Oracle Junction in southern Pinal County and is approximately one and one-quarter (1½) miles east of Highway 79 and one-quarter (½) miles north of Highway 77. This location provides easy access to the Tucson metro area on Highway 77 south as well as to Florence and the Phoenix metro area via Highway 79 north. See Figure 1, Regional Map and Figure 2, Area Map.

The purpose of this application is to obtain County approval for CI-1, TR, CB-2, CR-3 and CR-5 underlying zoning with a Planned Area Development (P.A.D.) zoning overlay. The proposed SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. is designed to implement the agreements made by the County in the PPDRP and the Supplement to the PPDRP, and to be in conformance with the Falcon Valley Area Plan. This SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. application provides for land uses, densities and intensities that are within the ranges specified for the Property in the Falcon Valley Area Plan.

Although this SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. application proposes land uses, densities and intensities within the range originally contemplated for subject property in the Falcon Valley Area Plan, this application proposes refinements to the zoning classifications and site design parameters to reduce both the commercial intensity and residential density from that permitted for the Property in the Falcon Valley Area Plan. The architecture, design, quality of improvements and landscaping incorporated into this SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. satisfies the "Goals and Policies" and "Design Guidelines" of the Falcon Valley Area Plan consistent with the PPDRP.

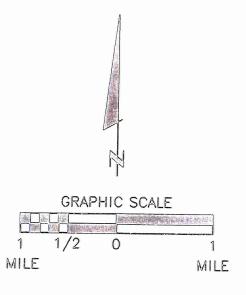


REGIONAL MAF

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL

A. Existing Conditions

In order to give a description of the proposal to develop SaddleBrooke Ranch, it is necessary to discuss the existing conditions of the project area and evaluate the opportunities and constraints which are available to the site. Figure 3, "Opportunities and Constraints" has delineated the natural features and man-made improvements within the SaddleBrooke Ranch project area.

The proposed SaddleBrooke Ranch is a portion of the deeded lands formerly owned by Falcon Valley Ranch, Inc. and part of the Falcon Valley Ranch operation, an active cattle ranching operation. The existing use of the Property is cattle grazing land. The proposed site consists of gently rolling terrain that slopes from the northeast to the southwest. Elevations range from approximately 3200 feet on the south to 3900 feet on the north. Existing slope across the project averages between 2% and 5%. The rolling terrain of the site forms four (4) washes that traverse through the project site roughly in a northeast to southwest direction. The most northerly of the four washes is named "Threeway Wash" on the U.S.G.S. map, while the three southerly washes are all unnamed. All four washes flow into "Big Wash", which is located approximately one-quarter (½) of a mile west of the westerly SaddleBrooke Ranch boundary. See Preliminary Drainage Report included as Appendix "A" of this narrative report.

There are a number of man-made features located on or adjacent to the SaddleBrooke Ranch project site. See Figure 3.

- 1.) There are three (3) holding tanks (cattle stock ponds) located within the project site:
 - a. The "Upper Holding Tank" is located in the SE¼ of Section 34 on the easterly end of the project site.
 - b. The "Threeway Tank" is located in the NE¼ of Section 32 in the northwesterly portion of the project site.
 - c. The "Toro Tank" is located in the SE½ of Section 5 in the southwesterly portion of the project site.
- 2.) A power transmission line crosses the northwesterly portion of SaddleBrooke Ranch (in the N½ of Section 32) within a 90-foot easement.
- 3.) A second power line crosses the project site running east to west along the north line of Township 10 South within a 60-foot easement.
- 4.) Offsite there is an abandoned United States missile site in the N½ of Section 3 between Highway 77 and the project boundary.
- 5.) Offsite is the Page Trowbridge Agriculture Experimental Range that studies arid agriculture practices and includes a closed dumpsite belonging to the University of Arizona, located adjacent to the northerly boundary of the project on Sections 33 and 34.

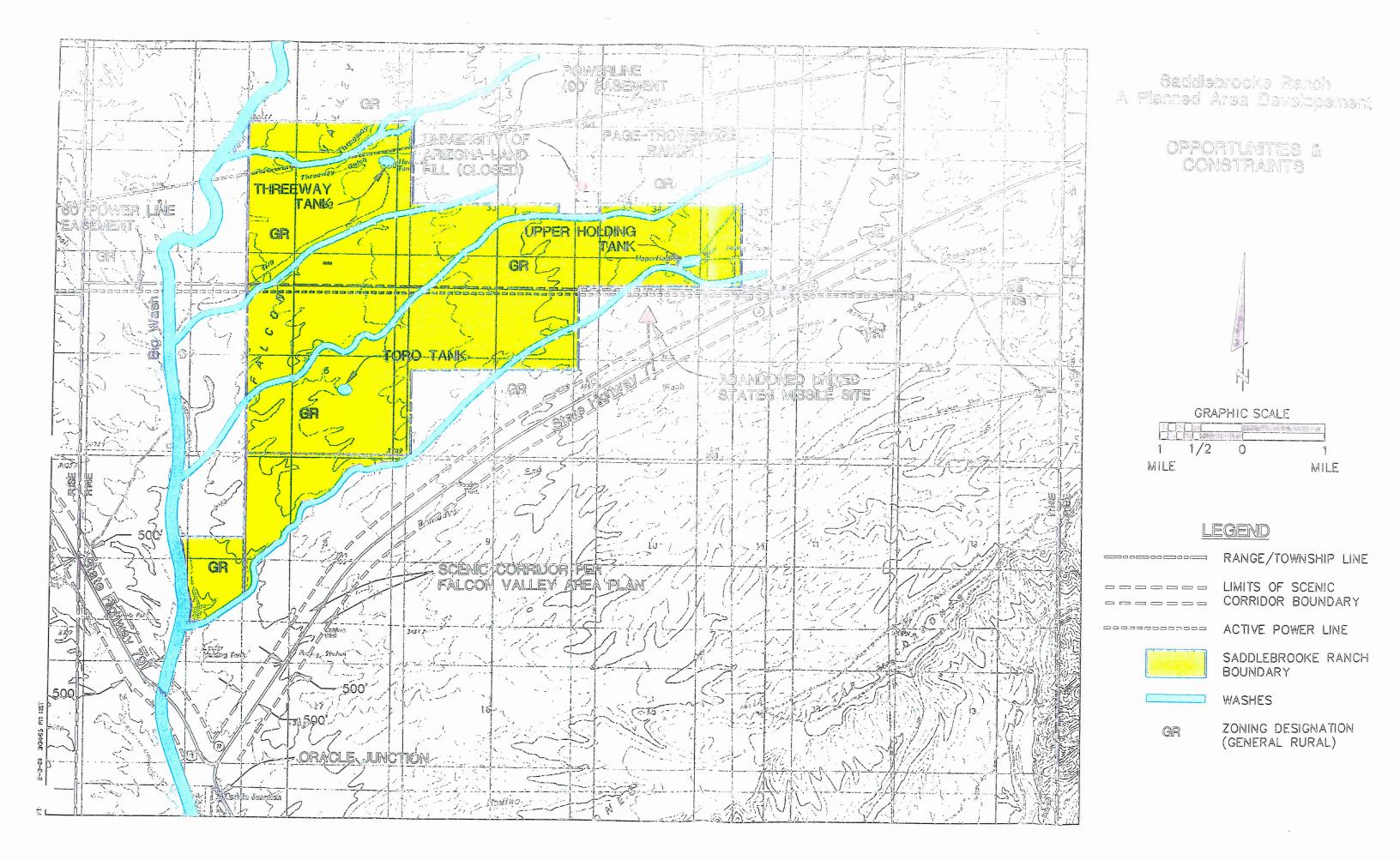

B. Proposed Development

In accordance with the Phased Protected Development Rights Agreement (PPDRP) entered into between the County and the owner of the Property, SaddleBrooke Ranch is planned for development as a private, gated, golf-oriented active adult community similar to the existing SaddleBrooke Resort Community to the south (See Figure 1). The project is expected to feature three (3) eighteen-hole golf courses and three (3) clubhouse facilities. Typical clubhouse facilities, built by affiliates of the SaddleBrooke Ranch developer in previous projects, have included a main clubhouse building with an auditorium, a golf pro-shop, bar and grill, fitness facility, arts and crafts building and a tennis center. Figure 4, Existing Ownership and Zoning, identifies public/private land ownership and existing zoning of the subject property and surrounding area.

SaddleBrooke Ranch will incorporate the majority of natural and existing man-made features into the development. The four (4) washes discussed in "Existing Conditions" will be left in near-natural condition (including their tree canopy), allowing offsite storm water to pass through the development. These washes will be incorporated into a planned private walking trail system, where appropriate. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has determined that 401 and 404 permits will be required for this project. These permits are being processed concurrently with this zoning application. Golf courses will be designed adjacent to the washes to avoid interruption of off-site stormwater flows while maintaining natural desert habitat. Where possible and compatible selected "spurs" feeding the washes will also be incorporated into the golf course design to provide interest, challenge and natural beauty to the golf experience and natural desert setting.

Of the three (3) man-made cattle stock tanks, both Upper Holding Tank and Threeway Holding Tank (shown on the U.S.G.S. maps) are older and have a significant growth of trees and shrubs. Therefore, these two (2) tanks will be incorporated into the golf course design. Toro Holding Tank is of relatively recent construction, has no vegetation growth and will be removed. The existing power lines running through the development are expected to remain, and if they do, their easements will be incorporated into golf course and/or landscaped as open-space corridors.

The Proposed Land Use Map (Figure 8) shows intended uses within SaddleBrooke Ranch, including clubhouses, a commercial parcel, resort hotel and residential areas. Legal descriptions for these specific zoning uses have been included as Appendix "B".

Residential development is expected to consist of three (3) different housing types;

1.) Luxury/Premiere Series Homes – This is a single family detached home product having a minimum lot width of 65 feet and a depth of 112 feet. The yield of this housing series is approximately 3.5 Residences per Net Acre (RAC). Base zoning for the Luxury/Premiere Series Homes will be CR-3. 2.) Casita Series Homes – This is a single family detached home product having a minimum lot width of 55 feet and a depth of 90 feet. The yield of this housing series is approximately 5.0 R.A.C. This housing series would be developed per Section 2325 for the Pinal County Zoning Ordinance, and the base zoning will be CR-3, reduced.

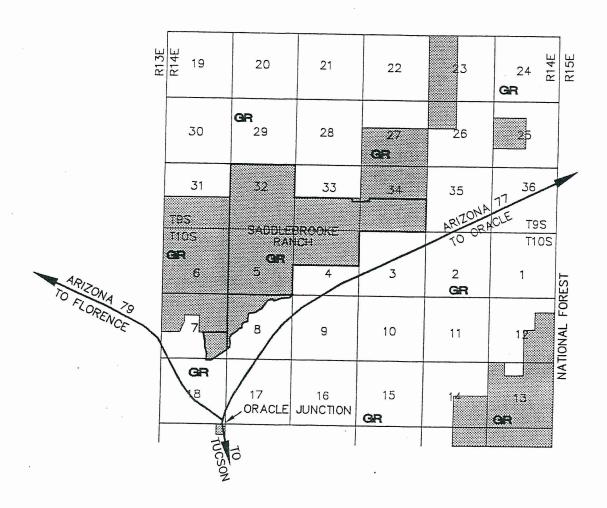
Both the Luxury/Premiere Series and Casita Series Homes fall within the Falcon Valley Area Plan Medium Residential Density category designation of 3-6 homes per acre. The Luxury/Premiere Series Homes have been built by SaddleBrooke Development Company, an affiliate of the Developer, in the SaddleBrooke Resort Community development since 1986, and the Casita Series Homes have been built by another affiliate of the Developer in the PebbleCreek development since 1992. See Figures 5 and 6, Typical Minimum Lots Luxury/Premiere Series Homes and Casita Series Homes respectively. Brochures of these homes have been included in Appendix "E".

3.) The third residential housing category is designated M.F. (Multi-Family) (See Figure 8) and could be developed in a variety of ways. Multi-Family could be developed as Apartments, Townhomes, Condominiums or an assisted living facility. The M.F. series would fall within the Falcon Valley Area Plan Medium-High Residential Density category designation of 6-12 residents per acre and have a base zoning of CR-5. A site plan for each M.F. land use will be processed by the Developer. Planned Area Development — Plan reductions have been included as Appendix "C" which identify proposed locations of multi-family sites (Sheet 2 of 6).

The commercial development typically associated with a community of this type consists of neighborhood-related retail, such as a market, barbershop, cleaners, travel agency, etc. These services are dictated by the needs of the community as it develops. Specific site plan review and approval will be required by the County prior to issuance of building permits for construction of any commercial facilities.

Industrial zoning is being requested for both the domestic water-storage facilities and the water reclamation facility (See Figures 8 and 13). Site plans for both of these facilities will be submitted to Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the County for review and approval prior to issuance of permits.

A full size set of plans, consisting of six (6) sheets, showing the proposed development are being submitted concurrently with this narrative report. Reductions of these plans are provided in Appendix "C".

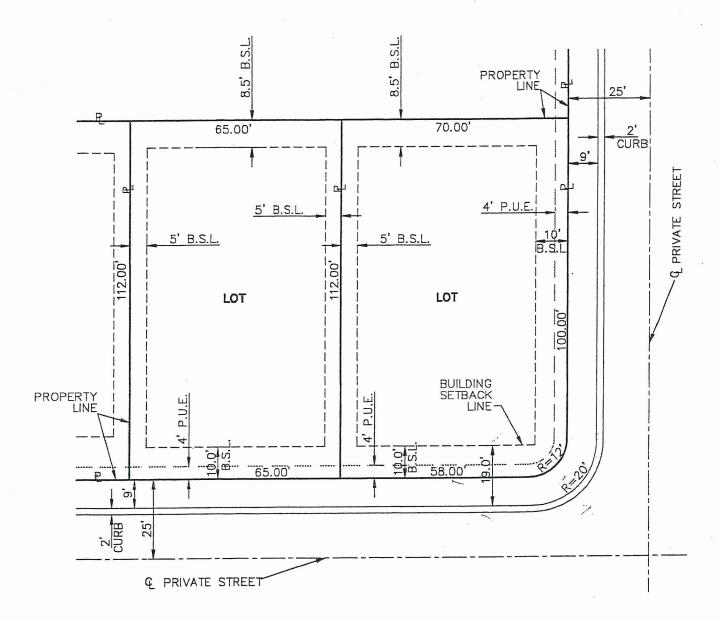

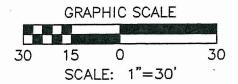
EXISTING ZONING GENERAL RURAL (GR)



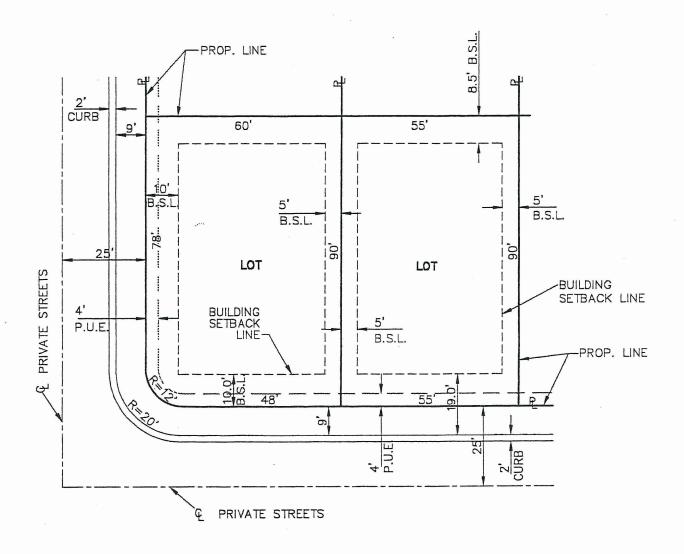


TYPICAL MINIMUM "LUXURY/PREMIERE SERIES LOTS"

WITH PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS AND MINIMUM BUILDING SETBACKS

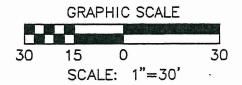






TYPICAL MINIMUM "CASITA SERIES LOTS"

3. COMPARISON OF "FALCON VALLEY AREA PLAN" AND "SADDLEBROOKE RANCH - P.A.D.

A. Falcon Valley Area Plan

The Falcon Valley Area Plan (approved by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors January 11, 1988) consists of 37,370 acres of land of which 6,379 acres are private deeded lands, and 30,991 acres of State of Arizona public lands. The central core of the Area Plan is a 7,100-acre Planned Community. The Planned Community consists of 4,110 acres of deeded lands and 2,990 acres of State lands with a maximum density yield of 21,213 dwelling units or 2.99 dwelling units to the gross acre of the 7,100 acres Planned Community.

Land uses within the 7,100-acre Planned Community of the Falcon Valley Area Plan consist of:

B. SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D.

SaddleBrooke Ranch, a Planned Area Development of 2,528 acres, consists of 2,253 acres of deeded lands purchased from Falcon Valley Ranch, Inc., and 275 acres of land purchased from the Arizona State Land Department. SaddleBrooke Ranch will be developed as a private, mixed-use, golf-orientated adult-community. The 2,528-acre SaddleBrooke Ranch Development is located entirely within the 7,100 acre "Planned Community" of the Falcon Valley Area Plan. The SaddleBrooke Ranch boundary was superimposed on the Falcon Valley Area Plan to establish a land-use comparison for the two plans. Table No. 1, "Land Use Comparison", shows areas in acres of similar uses of both Falcon Valley Area Plan (FV) and SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. (SR).

- * Commercial development designated on the Area Plan consists of two 30-acre "Village Centers" and one 20-acre "Opportunity Area" for a total of 80 acres. SaddleBrooke Ranch is designating a 39-acre commercial center and three separate clubhouse facilities equaling 73 acres for a total of 112 acres of CB-2. All of these uses would be permitted under the 201 acres of "Transitional" land use provided for in the Falcon Valley Area Plan.
- ** The Industrial zoning proposed for SaddleBrooke Ranch addresses a change in Pinal County policy for uses like the Waste Water Reclamation Facility and the Domestic Water Storage Facility. Previously, these facilities were allowed under Special Use Permits. The narrative portion of the Falcon Valley Area Plan acknowledged the necessity for these facilities but did not designate sites
- Medium Density on the Falcon Valley area Plan is described as a residential density range of 3-6 dwelling units to the acre. SaddleBrooke Ranch is proposing two separate single-family detached housing products with both falling in the Medium Density range. The Luxury Luxury/Premiere Series homes have a density yield of 3.5± dwelling units per net acre, the Casita Series homes have a density yield of 5.0± dwelling units per net acre.
- The area designated "Transitional" on the Falcon Valley Area Plan is the 115- acre Town Center. Allowed uses within the Town Center are described in the narrative portion of the Area Plan as Commercial, Medical, Office/Service, Churches, Schools, Community Facilities and also includes Medium-High Residential. The area designated "Transitional" on the SaddleBrooke Ranch P.A.D. is the 31.4-acre site of the Resort Hotel, or possibly as other Transitional Zoning allowed uses.

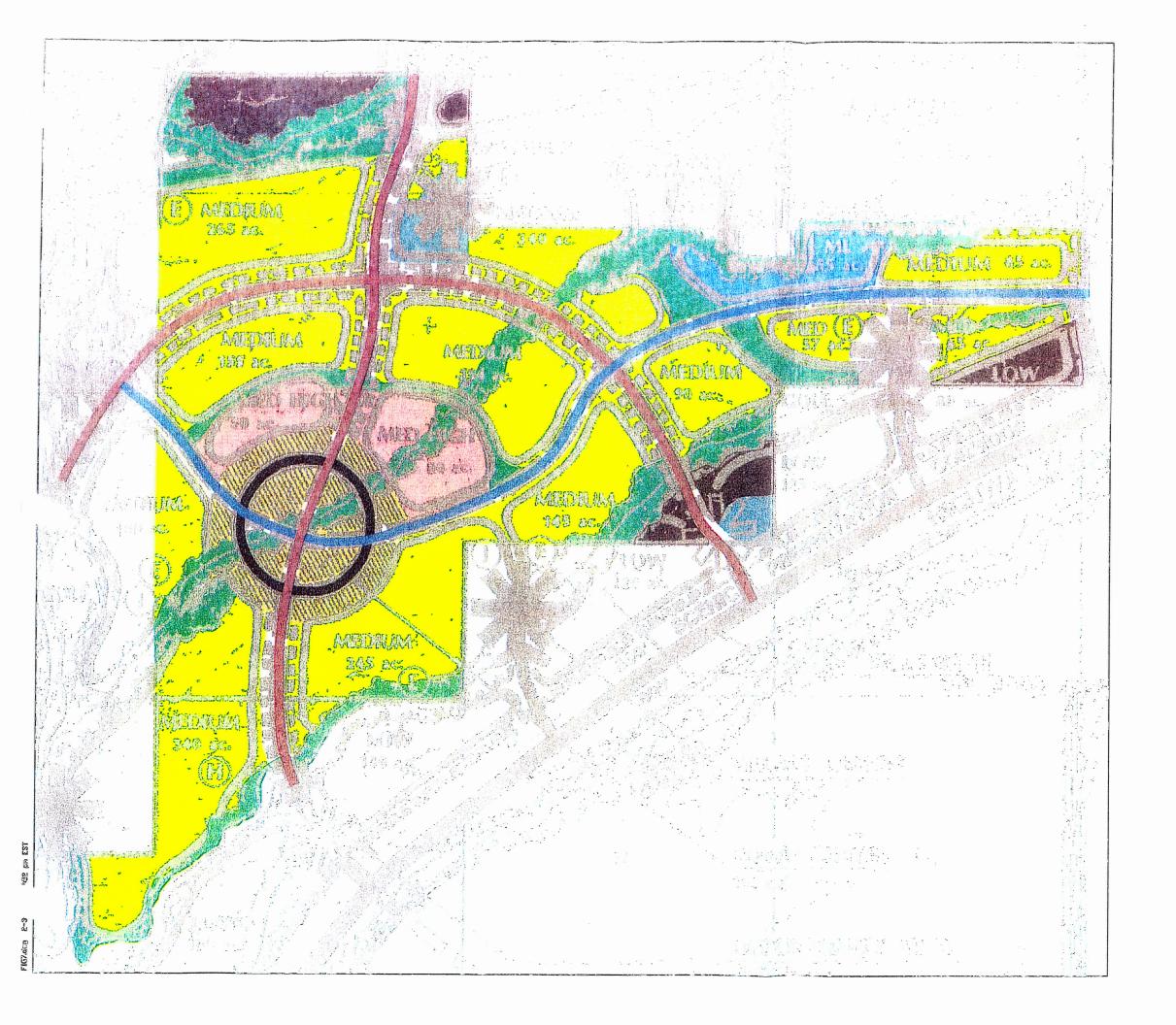

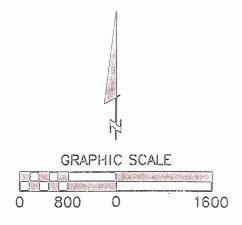

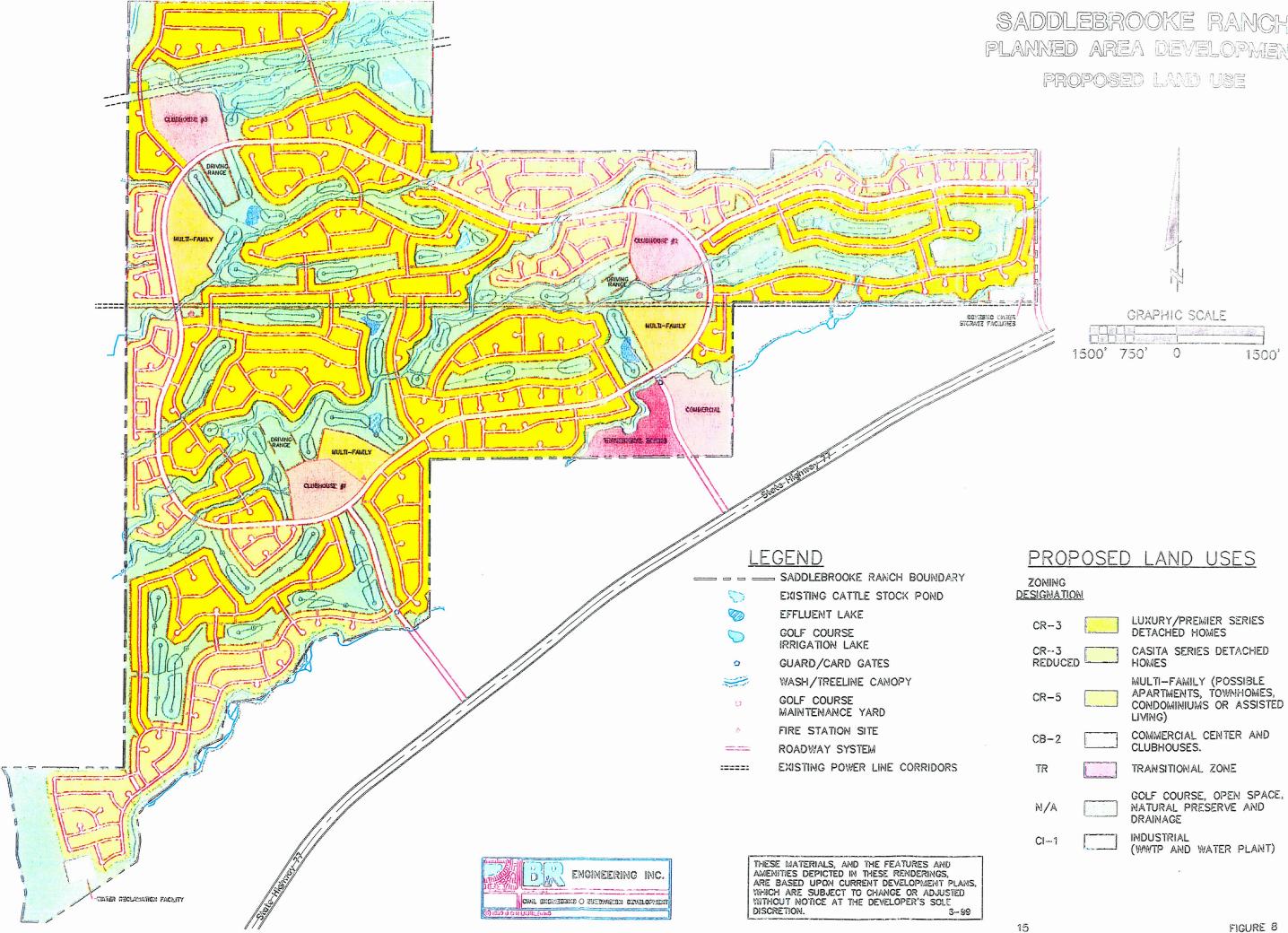
"Approved Land Uses Falcon Valley Area Plan" (Approved 1-11-88)











4. RELATIONSHIP TO SURROUNDING PROPERTIES

SaddleBrooke Ranch and all surrounding lands are currently zoned G.R. (General Rural). The majority of the surrounding land is public, and owned by the State of Arizona. Falcon Valley Ranch, located immediately west of SaddleBrooke Ranch, retains ownership of 1200± acres and will continue to operate its cattle ranching activities on its own private land and through the leased grazing rights from the State of Arizona. Since this is an age-restricted community, there will be no impact on area schools.

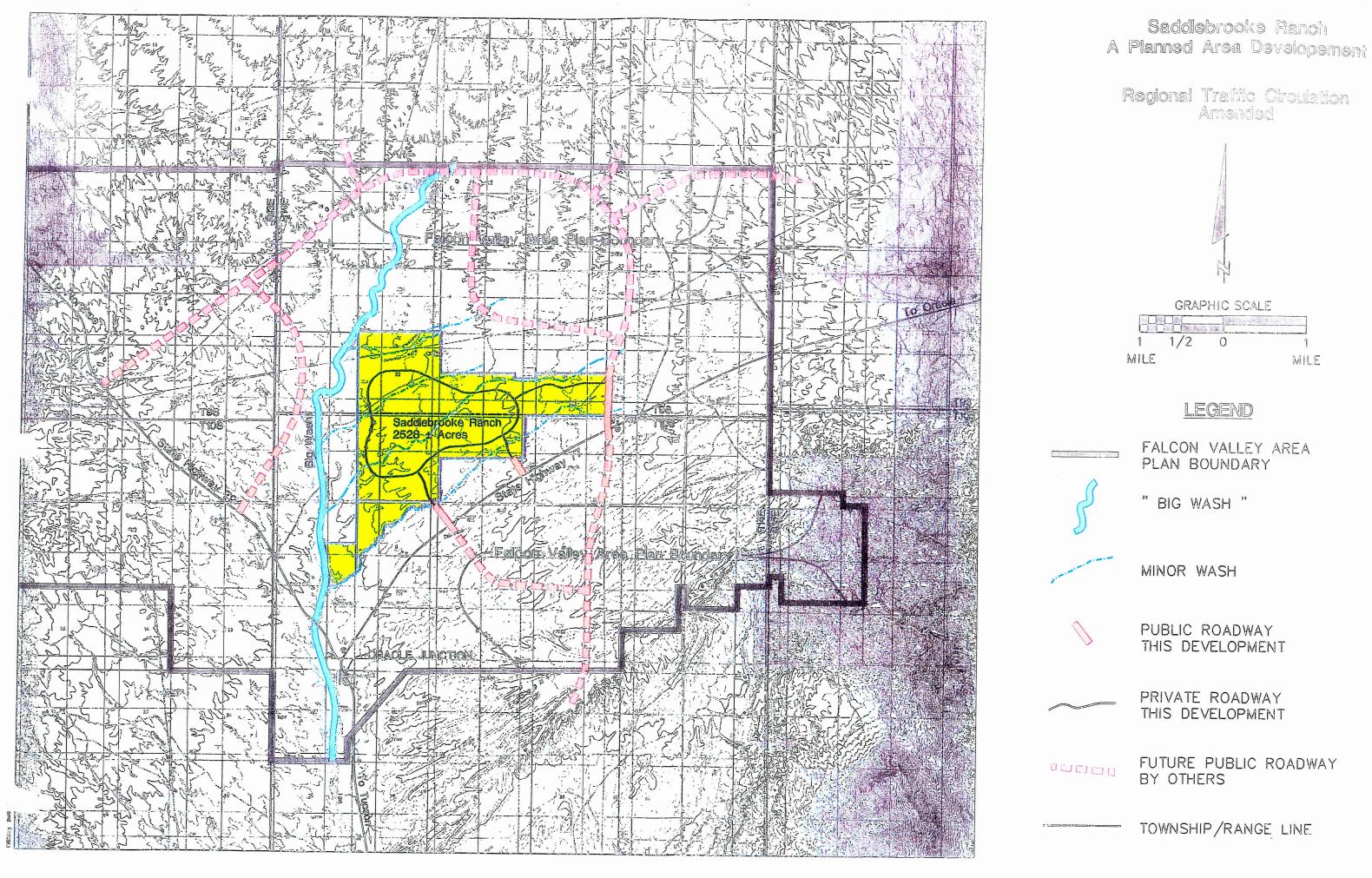
5. LOCATION AND ACCESSIBILITY

The southwest corner of the SaddleBrooke Ranch boundary is approximately one-quarter mile (¼) north of Oracle Junction (the intersection of State Highways 77 and 79). The entire SaddleBrooke Ranch property is located on the easterly side of Big Wash. Big Wash is the primary wash that drains the entire watershed of the Falcon Valley area.

Access to the Property will be from Highway 77 with three (3) separate entry roads. These access roads will be public roadways from Highway 77 to the guard gates, which will be located within this development (see Figure 8). A traffic study addressing these entry road locations has been approved by A.D.O.T. All internal roadways of SaddleBrooke Ranch will be private. The public roadway portion of the entry roads may be used for access to the State owned land between SaddleBrooke Ranch and Highway 77. All three (3) access roads will utilize a 110-foot right-of-way street section. A traffic impact study will be prepared for the SaddleBrooke Ranch project and submitted to the County for review concurrent with the P.A.D. zoning application.

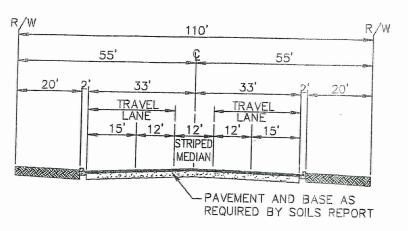
The vehicular circulation concept for the private community includes a 120-foot rightof-way loop road that will collect and convey the development traffic to the three (3) project access roads. The most easterly of the three access roads will continue north to provide future access to the undeveloped Page-Trowbridge Ranch and State Lands lying north of SaddleBrooke Ranch. A 100-foot right-of-way interior collector road is planned on the easterly portion of SaddleBrooke Ranch connecting the loop road to the easterly public access road. All local roadways in SaddleBrooke Ranch will be 50-foot right-of-ways, and 32 feet back to back of curb. The private character of SaddleBrooke Ranch with a gated private roadway system has necessitated minor amendments to the future regional traffic system delineated on the Falcon Valley Area Plan map. The revised Regional Traffic Circulation is consistent with the Circulation Element and the Goals & Policies of the Area Plan and was discussed with Pinal County staff at the SaddleBrooke Ranch preapplication conference. The revised Regional Traffic Circulation would allow undeveloped lands east of Big Wash access from Highway 77 and land west of Big Wash access from Highway 79. See Figure 10 for public and private roadway sections, and Figure 9 for Regional Traffic Circulation Amended.

Another key aspect of the circulation system for this private community is golf cart and pedestrian circulation. SaddleBrooke Ranch is proposing that the onsite private portion of the entry access roads, the 120-foot loop road and the 100-foot east/west collector road have an off-pavement two-way golf cart path on one side of the road and a 5-foot pedestrian sidewalk on the opposite side of the road. Some of the existing washes will also include walkways to provide pedestrian access and linkage through the community. See Figure 11, Golf Cart and Pedestrian Circulation Map.

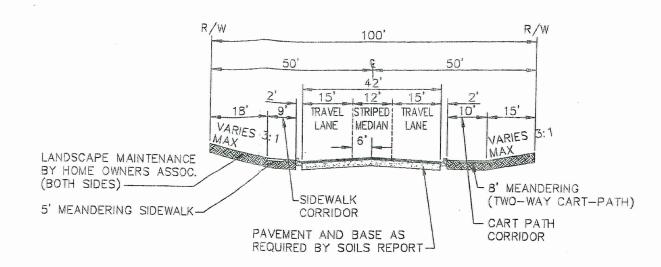

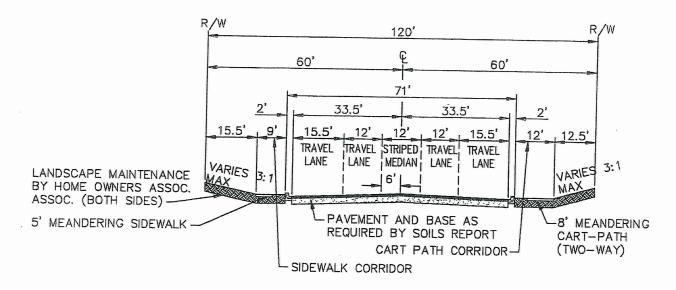

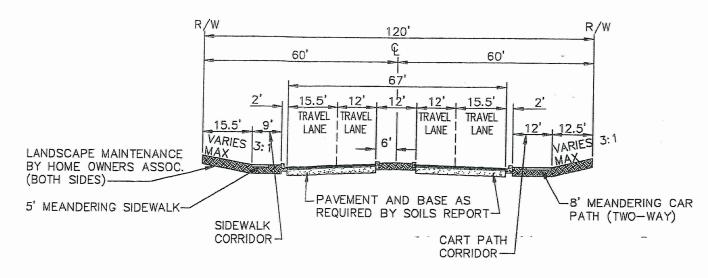
100' RIGHT-OF-WAY PRIVATE COLLECTOR ROAD W/STRIPED MEDIAN, SIDEWALK & CART PATH



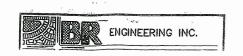

6. TIMING OF DEVELOPMENT

It is anticipated that the first golf course will be open for play and the first homes will be available for sale by the end of the year 2003. The first development phase will be Clubhouse #1, its golf course, surrounding residential development, water reclamation facility and water storage facility. The second development phase will be Clubhouse #2, its golf course and surrounding residential development. The third development phase will be Clubhouse #3, its golf course and surrounding residential development.

The commercial parcel probably will be developed when sufficient resident population base is established for the community to support the commercial property. Development of the resort hotel is likely to be the final development phase of the project. Development of SaddleBrooke Ranch is anticipated to continue for a minimum of twenty (20) years. Given this development time line, it is expected that the plan will have minor extensions, alterations and modifications as described in Section 3308 of the Pinal County Zoning Ordinance, including density transfers.

7. UTILITIES AND SERVICES

Utilities and Services will be provided by both public and private entities. Service agreement letters have been included in Appendix "D".

POLICE PROTECTION will be provided by the Pinal County Sheriff's Department. The homeowners' association will man the entry gates to the community.

FIRE PROTECTION and AMBULANCE service will be provided by Golder Ranch Fire District.

CABLE TELEVISION services will be provided by a cable television company, which may be affiliated with the Developer.

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL will be provided by Waste Management Company by private contract.

TELEPHONE services will be provided by U.S. West Communications Company.

NATURAL GAS will be provided by Southwest Gas Company.

ELECTRIC POWER services will be provided by Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc.

POTABLE WATER will be provided by Arizona Water Company.

Arizona Water Company will provide potable water to the development from an independent water system consisting of on-site groundwater wells, pumps, storage tanks, and distribution lines. The onsite waterlines will be looped through the development and range in size from 6 to 16 inches in diameter as shown in Figure 12. Fire hydrants will be located in coordination with the local fire department. Distribution pressures will be maintained according to the requirements of the

Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. The potable water will meet the requirements of the Federal and State Drinking Water Acts.

Potable water will be pumped from up to six (6) wells in the development to storage tanks at the domestic water storage facilities site. The water storage facilities will consist of booster pumps and a storage tank system and will be constructed at the northeast portion of the development. Two (2) pressure zones are planned based on topography. The upper zone, east of Clubhouse #2 will be fed water from the water storage facilities by a set of booster pumps and a 12-inch diameter waterline, and a 12-inch diameter loop waterline with 6-inch and 8-inch connections. An inter-tie connection between the two pressure zones will be added on the north part of the development through three 8-inch diameter waterlines with pressure regulating valves. The lower zone (below elevation 3595) will be gravity fed on one (1) or two (2) water storage tanks at the water storage facility.

Pumping rates for this project will result in an aquifer drawn down which meets the requirements of the Arizona Department of Water Resources. A master water plan will be submitted to the County for review and approval concurrently with submittal of tentative plats for this development.

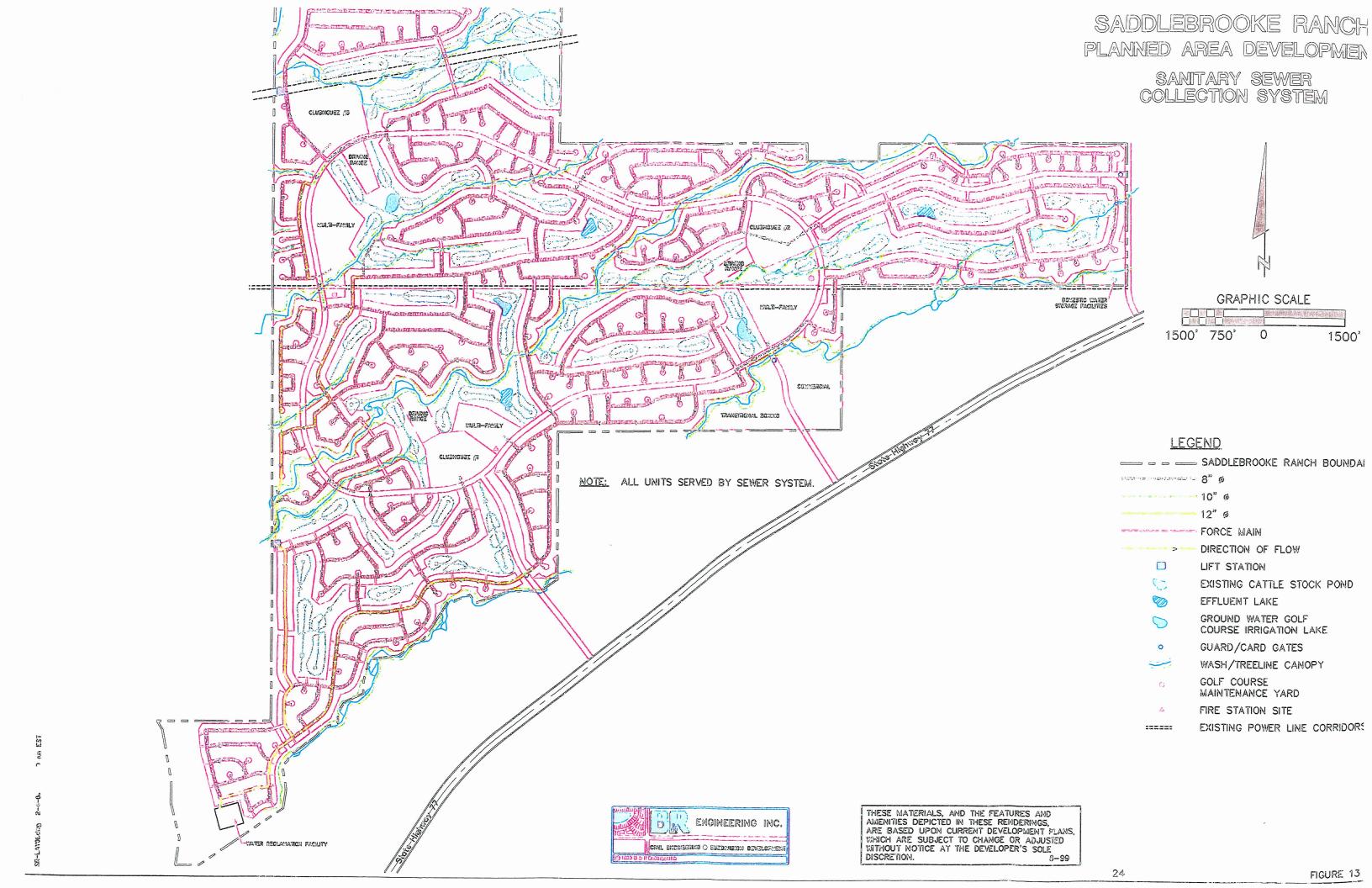
SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM

The sewer collection system will convey wastewater from east to west-southwest to a proposed water reclamation facility at the southwestern corner of the development. Sewers range in size from 8 to 12 inches in diameter will collect the wastewater and convey it to the reclamation facility, as shown in Figure 13. Two lift stations will be required because of the topography of the development to convey the collected wastewater to the reclamation facility. One lift station will pump wastewater from the northern portion of the development southerly to the gravity sewer system (see Figure 13). The other lift station will be the influent lift station for the reclamation facility. The collection system and reclamation facility will be operated by the Mountain Pass Sewer Company and will meet federal, state, and county regulations.

The reclamation facility will treat the wastewater to aquifer water quality standards and applicable surface water standards. Sewage from the development will be treated in a U.S. Filter/ Davco package plant with anoxic and aerobic zones, and a primary clarifier. The process will nitrify and denitrify of the wastewater and separate the solids in an aerobic digester. The effluent will be filtered and ultraviolet light will disinfect the treated effluent before it is delivered for use on the golf courses, filling the lakes, discharging to wash through a NPDES permit or recharging the aquifer. This facility will also have odor control.

A master sewer plan will be submitted to the County for review and approval concurrently with submittal of tentative plat for this development.

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8. MAINTENANCE OF STREETS, COMMON AREAS AND GOLF COURSES

Maintenance of all private streets, common areas, public entry roadway landscaping and community facilities will be the responsibility of the developer until such time as their operation is turned over to the Homeowner's Association. Landscaping of common areas, golf courses, collector roadways, as well as color and materials of walls and buildings will be similar in color and character to the facilities constructed at the SaddleBrooke development located to the south of this project. Ownership and maintenance of the golf courses and pro-shops will remain with the developer, it's affiliates, their assignee, or the Homeowner's Association. However, clubhouses, recreation facilities and open spaces will be owned and maintained by the Homeowner's Association. A preliminary copy of SaddleBrooke Ranch CC&R's has been included with the submittal as a separate document.

A development the size and duration of SaddleBrooke Ranch will require a variety of Temporary Use and/or Special Use permits throughout the life of the project. A separate application for each Temporary or Special Use will be submitted to the County at a later date. A partial list of the type of facilities that may require Temporary or Special Uses would be:

- 1. Construction yards.
- 2. Homebuilder and administration office.
- 3. Cable T.V. tower and satellite dishes.
- 4. Nursery area for storage of on-site plants to be relocated.
- 5. Temporary starter facilities for the golf course.
- 6. Temporary sales trailer.
- 7. Sales office and Model Village

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to investigate the development of SaddleBrooke Ranch, a planned retirement community of approximately 2528 acres. This report will address the following considerations:

Pre-development Conditions

- 1. Existing Onsite Drainage
- 2. Offsite Drainage

Developed Conditions

- 1. Method of handling onsite runoff and utilizing onsite detention
- 2. Method of managing offsite runoff
- 3. Impact on surrounding areas

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

SaddleBrooke Ranch is a proposed 2528-acre planned development located at Oracle Junction in southern Pinal County approximately one and one-quarter miles east of Highway 89 and one-quarter mile north of Highway 77 (see Regional Map, Figure 1). The project consists of Section 32, portions of the South half of Sections 33 and 34, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, G&SRB&M and the North half of Section 4, all of Section 5 and portions of Sections 7 and 8, Township 10 South, Range 14 East, G&SRB&M, Pinal County, Arizona. (See Vicinity Map, Figure 2). A more detailed description of the project can be found in Appendix "C", pages 5 and 6 of 6, Rezoning Parcel Map and Legal Description. The proposed development will consist of future single family residential areas, multi-family residential housing, residential street right-ofways, open space areas, commercial areas and three eighteen hole golf courses each with clubhouse areas.

This report will address the disposition of runoff generated by the project. The method of handling the onsite runoff will be to store and meter its flows through a series of off wash detention areas within the golf course. These detention areas will ultimately discharge into the existing major washes within the project. These washes are shown in Figure 3 and include:

- 1. Wash A
- 2. Wash B
- 3. Wash C
- 4. Wash E
- 5. Wash M

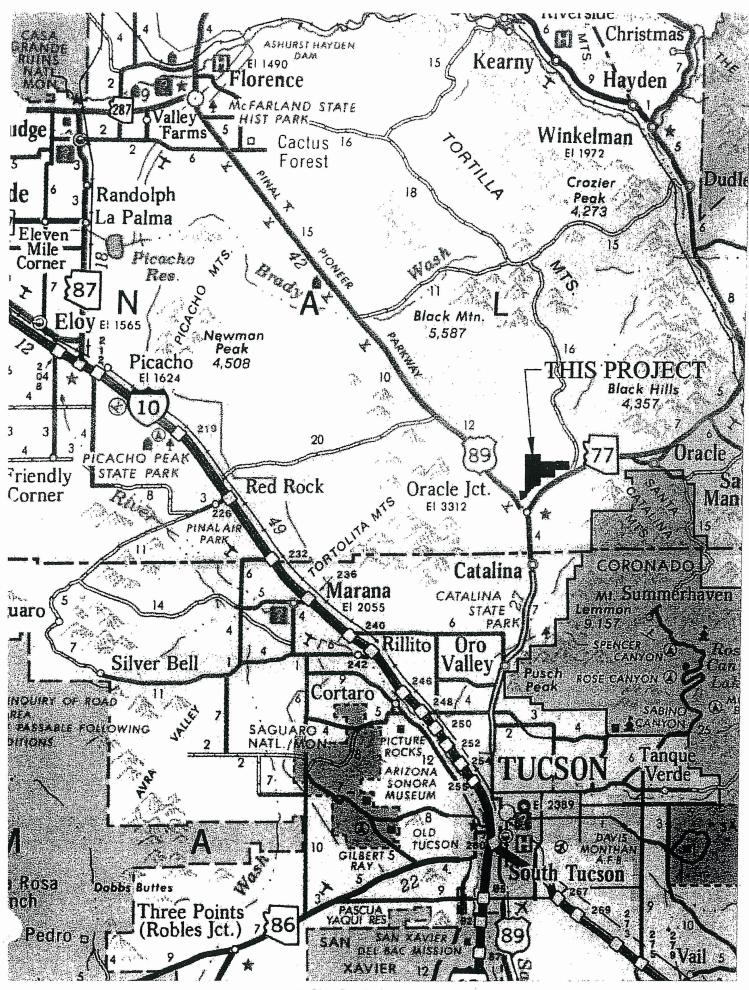
Through this series of detention areas and existing washes, the post-development peak runoff leaving the site on the western boundary will be equal to or less than existing peak runoff, as per Pinal County regulations.

PRE-DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONS

Description of Onsite Drainage Characteristics

At this time, the existing onsite land is not in use for a specific purpose. Previously the property was owned by the Wilson family and was used as cattle grazing land. The proposed site consists of gently rolling terrain that slopes from northeast to the southwest. The property is traversed by four large washes, and one smaller wash, which will remain and be addressed in this report.

Existing onsite runoff generally flows from the northeast to the southwest, and outlets from the property at Concentration Points (CP) E2, C2, B2, A2, A3, A5, and M on the Existing Conditions Map, Figure 3, page 6. HEC-1 estimated onsite and offsite runoff from these outlet points is contained within Table 1, page 5, for the 100-year storm.

Description of Offsite Drainage Conditions

As mentioned above, the proposed site for SaddleBrooke Ranch is impacted by offsite runoff basically from the east/northeast. The drainage areas generating this runoff can be seen in Figure 3 and include Sub-basins E1, C1, B1, A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6 and O. Sub-basin (SB) E1 extends approximately 3.75 miles to the east. Runoff from this area enters the property at CP E1. SB C1 extends approximately 6.8 miles, also to the east. Runoff from this area enters the property at CP C1. The same is true for SBs B1, and A1. SB B1 extends to the east approximately 4.4 miles and SB A1 extends in the same direction approximately 0.66 miles. Other offsite drainage areas A2, A3, A4 and A5 consist of runoff not necessarily entering the project but are conveyed by wash A. SB O extends about 2.7 miles easterly. Runoff from this area drains to CP O1 and to an existing cattle pond (named Upper Holding Tank) that will be renamed Lake 13 in our proposed drainage plan. Natural terrain serves as the drainage cutoff boundaries of the furthest offsite areas. Runoff flow from these mentioned offsite areas can be found in Table 2.

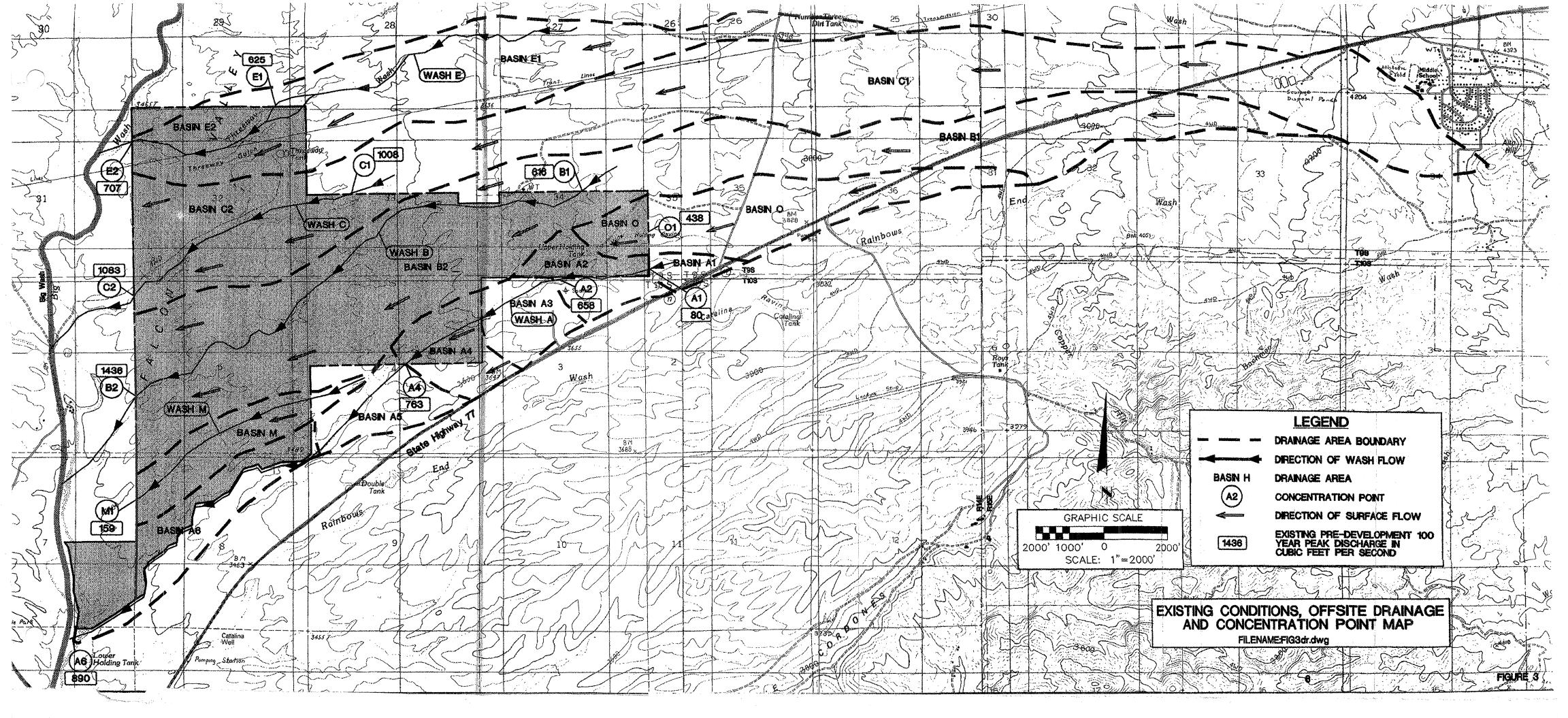

PROPOSED MASTER DRAINAGE PLAN

Onsite

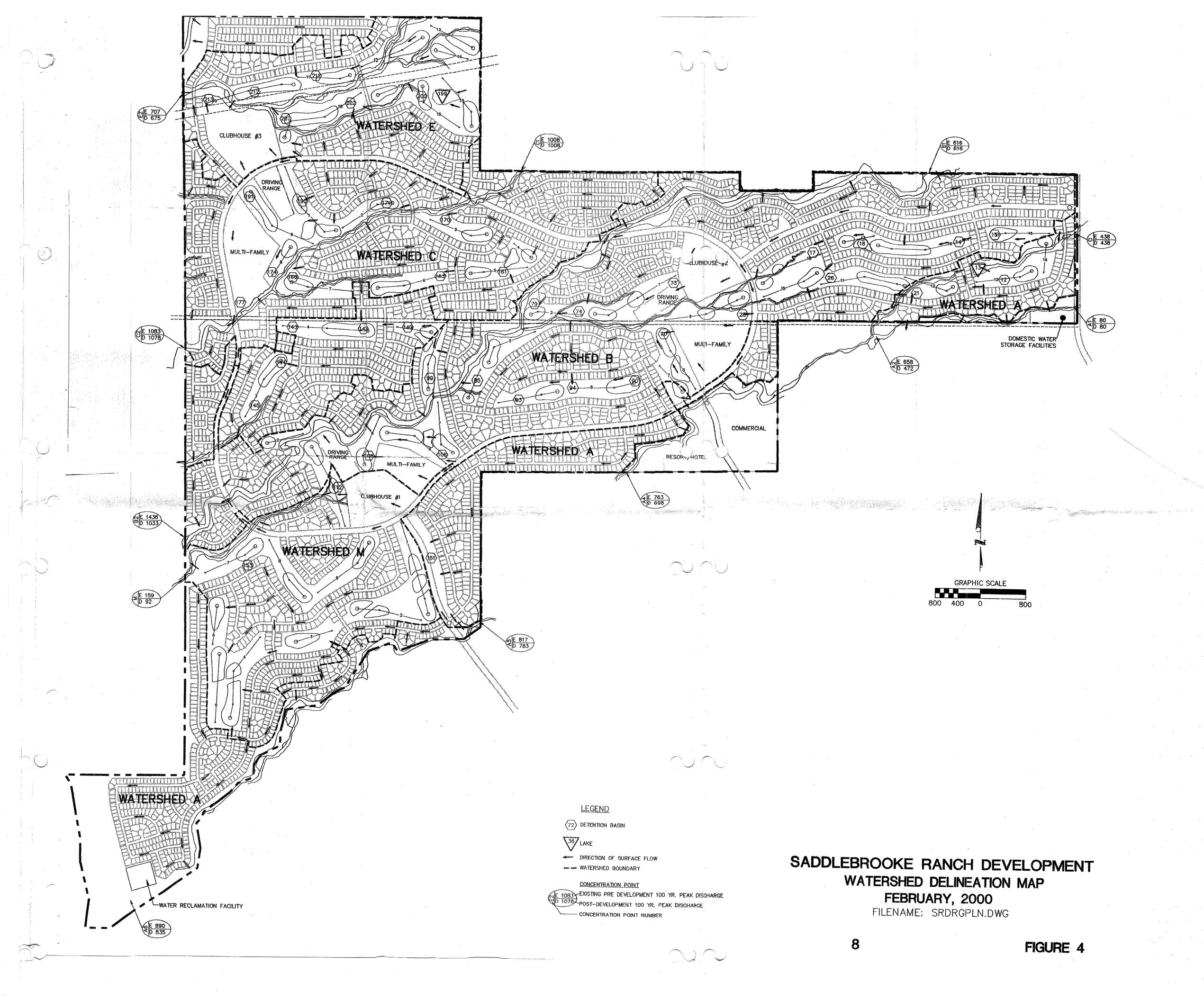


Figure 4 shows major Watersheds A, B, C, E, and M. Runoff from lots, streets, open space areas, and etc. within these watersheds will be conveyed through streets and various drainage structures into the golf course detention basins or directly into an existing wash. Runoff within the golf course will be metered to the next downstream basin for detention or drain directly into an existing wash.

The proposed master drainage plan is shown on Figure 4.

Drainage within the SaddleBrooke Ranch development will consist of future single family residential areas, drainageways, multi-family residential, street right-of-ways, open space areas, commercial areas, and three eighteen hole golf courses and clubhouse areas.

The proposed drainage system will contain the following elements:

- 1. Drain all lots to the street they front on.
- 2. Drain streets to local low points.
- 3. Drain local low points on streets to detention areas or lakes on the golf course or into the existing wash.
- 4. Meter flow out of detention areas/lakes to adjacent downstream washes.
- 5. Meter runoff downstream ultimately to five major wash outlet points, Concentration Points E2, B2, C2, A6 and M (see Figure 3).

Analysis Method

The method used in this report studies the existing and post-development peak runoff at all the project boundaries for the 100-year duration rainfall. Base data for the area was obtained from the Arizona Department of Transportation publication "<u>Highway Drainage Design Manual – Hydrology</u>", revised April 1994 and rainfall data provided by "<u>N.O.A.A. ATLAS 2</u>". The data was input into the version of HEC-1 computer program called ProHEC1 by Dodson and Associates. ProHEC1 is used to develop flood hydrographs that contain peak runoff values for sub-areas throughout the development. It develops flood hydrographs, routes flows through drainageways and detention areas, and combines flood hydrographs to give composite peak discharges and times at appropriate points within the total drainage area.

Watershed A is the southerly most area within the project. All of the runoff generated by Watershed A will be drained into adjacent open space or golf course detention or drained directly into Wash A. At every point along Wash A where critical predevelopment and post-development runoff flows are calculated, pre-development flows are greater than post-development flows.

Runoff from Watersheds B, C, D, E, and M will drain similarly to Watershed A but will drain to the particular wash bearing it's same designation. Within every area, including Watershed A, all detention is designed to detain the runoff generated by the 100-year storm event. All post-development runoff amounts compared with pre-development conditions can be seen in Table 3 at concentration points show in Figure 3.

Offsite

Offsite flows from drainage areas A1, E1, C1, B1, and O1 will enter the project site at various points on the eastern or northern boundary even after development (see Figure 3 for these concentration points). Runoff from these areas will be allowed to flow naturally through the site and will be combined with post-development flows from within the project. This combined runoff will then exit the project at the downstream concentration points shown on Figure 3 and listed in Table 3.

Detention Basin Routing

Onsite runoff, upon entering an off wash detention basin, will be detained and then will be routed downstream via stormdrain pipes to the adjacent downstream detention area, lake or wash. Storage routing results in storm\runoff being detained in a series of dry

detention areas interspersed throughout the golf course as denoted in Figure 4. These detention areas meter stormwater flows via a system of pipes, overflow weirs, or overland flows using graded swales or natural channels within the golf course. Outlet pipes have been designed to discharge flows without a significant backwater effect within the pipes or corresponding storage basin.

Subdivision Design

The anticipated method of handling storm drainage will be to collect subdivision lot stormwater runoff in adjacent streets. Building pads are set a minimum of 0.4' higher that the highest adjacent top of curb and/or the nearest drainageway highwater elevation. Finished floor grades are an additional 8" above pad grades. All lots in SaddleBrooke Ranch will be set above the 100-year high water elevation of adjacent detention areas.

Effects of the Project

The net effect of the project is that the 100-year storm runoff of Watershed's A, B, C, E and M (Figure 4) will be detained onsite. All watersheds will contribute to flows leaving the site, as well as the aforementioned offsite areas. Results in Table 3 show that runoff quantities will be either reduced or equal to the existing pre-development figures.

CONCLUSION

- There is a significant amount of onsite runoff from the pre-development project site.
- There is a significant amount of offsite runoff that will be allowed to enter the project boundaries via existing natural washes.
- For the post-development condition, much runoff from the 100-year storm in Watersheds A, B, C, E, and M will be detained onsite before being released.
- For the post-development condition, runoff not detained onsite will be released directly into the pre-development natural washes.
- The post-development peak runoff leaving the site at the western boundary will be equal to or less that existing peak runoff, as per Pinal County regulations.
